When: Tuesday  $16^{th}$  January 2024 at 2.30pm - 3.00pmWhere: Canford Heath Infant School



Through their PSHE lessons and TrickBox 'Happy Habits' assemblies, the children have already begun to learn a range of strategies, or 'tricks', to develop their confidence, emotional regulation techniques, positive communication skills and creative problem-solving skills. This is all part of a wider personal development curriculum that aims to promote and support positive mental health and emotional wellbeing in all our children.











