Does your child qualify for Premium Pupil funding?

Pupil Premium awards additional funding to schools to spend on pupils from low-income families, pupils with care or adoption orders and pupils who have parents in the armed forces. This extra funding is spent on the education of all these children which may include implementing interventions targeted to individual needs, as well as pastoral and emotional support. In addition, every pupil in receipt of Pupil Premium will receive a £50 allowance from the school to put towards the cost of the following:

- a school jumper or cardigan (infants)
- a school jumper, cardigan, or tie (juniors)
- a bookbag or PE bag
- one extra curricular after school club per academic year (school led)
- school trips and visits (with the exception of the Year 6 Activities Week)

If your child is currently eligible and registered for free school meals, they will also be entitled to the following:

- FREE music tuition for one instrument per academic year
- financial assistance towards the Year 6 Activities Week


