What a wonderful letter for us to write to you all today!! As you will be aware, on 21st and 22<sup>nd</sup> of March, we were inspected by Ofsted. We were last inspected 15 years ago, so we were keen to know that our continuous strive for excellence would be recognised.

We are absolutely delighted to let you know that <u>Canford Heath Infant School continues to be</u> Outstanding, under the new inspection framework. Since 2008, the inspection framework has changed a number of times, and is significantly different now. Outstanding is a challenging and exacting judgement and requires the following areas to be exceptional: quality of education, behaviour and attitudes, personal development, leadership and management and the quality of Early Years.


## We are so proud that our school has been graded 'Outstanding' in all areas:


- Overall effectiveness Outstanding

- Parents are overwhelmingly positive about the school, with many commenting on how the leaders and staff constantly go above and beyond."

Over the last year, only 4% of schools in the country have been graded outstanding using the current inspection framework. (Watchsted April 2023). Furthermore, we are also the first school in Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole to be graded Outstanding under the current framework.

We cannot express enough how extremely proud we are of our dedicated staff for all they do for the school every single day - and we know that this excellent outcome could not have been achieved without our fantastic children, families and community. We would also like to say a huge thank you for the feedback we received on Ofsted Parent View. To have 101 responses, with such overwhelmingly positive feedback, was incredible and something that, as a school team, we are hugely honoured to receive. It is fabulous to hear that 100% of those that completed the survey would recommend our school to another parent. As always, we highly value your contribution and involvement in making our school community one to be exceptionally proud of.

We are aware that there has been much discussion in the national press about Ofsted, its inspection processes and its impact on schools, and we understand and empathise with the variety of viewpoints on the grading system. Nonetheless, we see this 'Outstanding' grade as a reflection of everything the school does, every single day, to make it the best place to be for our children and staff — and we hope you will join us in being so, so proud of what this means about our practice and care for our little people.
