## YEAR 2 – Moors Valley Country Park Trip

For the children's final school trip at Canford Heath Infant School, we will be going on a special visit to Moors Valley Country Park in Ashley Heath. This is always a very memorable trip for Year 2 and a really exciting way to end the year before the children go onto their new schools.

If your child has a school lunch booked, they will be given a packed lunch to place in their own rucksack before departing on the trip.
